I hereby consent to the release of my enrollment status and grade point averages (cumulative and previous semesters) to the chapter advisor, president, scholarship chair, new member educator, Program Advisor for Greek Life, and national/international headquarters staff. The purpose of this disclosure is to verify eligibility for membership, verification of achievement of the chapter's minimum academic standards, awards recognition, and for use in chapter scholarship programming.

I understand that the South Dakota State University Greek Council Constitution and By-Laws require a 2.0 cumulative GPA in order to pledge/associate. If the chapter I wish to join requires a higher GPA than a 2.0, I authorize the Office of Student Activities to confirm my eligibility according to that chapter's requirements. I understand that my specific GPA will not be released prior to my becoming a member of a chapter, but that my eligibility to join will be confirmed.

I understand that a chapter GPA will be generated using my GPA and that this group score will not identify any named or unnamed individual's GPA. The chapter GPA will be released to the Program Advisor for Greek Life for the purposes of chapter promotion (i.e. news releases, national data gathering) and programming (i.e. scholarship programs). The subsequent release of the chapter GPA will be at the discretion of the Program Advisor for Greek Life.

This authorization shall remain in effect as long as I remain a member of the fraternity and am enrolled at South Dakota State University, unless I submit written revocation of this authorization to the Program Advisor for Greek Life.
